Art Show:

The “Beautifully Diverse World” art show was on display at the Kirksville Arts Center from April 16-26 with the reception/ Kirksville Area Chamber of Commerce After-Hours event on April 19th. Fifty eight artists submitted pieces to the show. There was a great community turn out for the reception and we received a lot of very positive feedback for the event. It would not have been so successful without the support and dedication of the planning committee, Chamber of Commerce, and Kirksville Arts Association.

Summer Program:

There are 14 students enrolled and ten staff hired for the Summer Youth Program. Since this is a significantly smaller number of participants than years in the past, the program will be headquartered at the Community Learning Center. This will reduce the cost by several thousand dollars, provide some benefits and also pose some challenges. It will take some effort to work out the different logistics, but we will continue to provide the highest quality programming possible to the students enrolled in the program, people and their support teams, and the community.

Other Engagement:

Our branding material is almost fully developed. The student designer working with us has done a great job communicating with us this semester to create marketing elements so that we can engage the community with a consistent message.

We are continuing the partnership with CAPNEMO this summer through their community garden program.
